### I. S&T ACTIVITIES

- The faculty members from NID, Bangalore visited CCRI & identified Vajra as a project for further development on the design of the machine to enhance productivity, minimize moving parts and producing good quality of yarn. The NID faculty members observed the demonstration of Vajra machine and viewed different types of coir products developed by the Product Diversification wing of CCRI.
- The Board has initiated action to solve the problem of soil erosion in the sloppy areas in Nilgiri District in Tamil Nadu by using Coir Geo-textiles.
