The Important Events/discussions/decisions pertaining to Coir Board for the period from 23.5.2016 to 22.6.2016 are furnished below.

## **S&T ACTIVITIES**

 The Board developed Chess Board pawns from Coir and Polyester using coir fibre and pith in natural colours and pigmented in Black/White. The Moulds were fabricated in Fiber glass using the master coins purchased from the market.



- Fabricated a prototype of Soundless Fibre Extraction Machine.
- The Board signed an MoU for undertaking a Collaborative Project on "Studies on Coir pith as an adsorbent in pollutant removal from waste water" with College of Engineering, Trivandrum".

- The R& D technologies developed by the Board viz the pollution free technologies of Biochem treatment for quality improvement of coir fibre, composting of coir pith using PITHPLUS, development of COCOLAWN, Coir Net House, Setting up of vertical garden and utilization of tender coconut husks as compost/ disposable glass/ paper were demonstrated and explained to the visitors from Erode, Tamil Nadu.
- The study on biodegradation of coir pith using fish waste / poultry litter as a substitute to Urea as nitrogen supplement has been taken up in our R&D institute. Samples of biodegraded coir pith were collected at frequent intervals from the composting heap and analyzed conforms to the standard values.
- The Board participated in the Seminar organized by MSME Training Institute, Thiruvalla at Social Service Society, Ranni on 25.05.2016. All the coir products developed by CCRI
   CICT were displayed on the occasion and brochures on the technologies/schemes/services of Coir Board were distributed to the interested visitors.
- Laying of Cocolawn was demonstrated at REC, Thanjavur during the period from 29.05.2016 to 31.05.2016.
- Coir based handmade paper glass and paper box were produced at the Coir Technology
   Incubation Centre.
