Report on Coir Board's Participation in

DOMOTEX

International Trade Fair

12th to 15th January, 2018 Hannover, Germany

Domotex Fair is one of the major events in the carpet exhibition all over the world. The leading players in the carpet field consider this fair as a prestigious one to participate and are participating continuously for the last so many years. This year's key note theme 'Unique Youniverse' provides exhibitors, next generation designers and artists with a platform to showcase this trend at Domotex. The talks and discussions of the event focussed on current issues and trends such as the individualization of flooring products.



Coir Board, being a statutory body constituted for the overall development of Coir Industry in India, is also a party to the mega show continuously for the last so many years and this year also the Board has participated in this event in a mega fashion.

The Fair held at Hannover from 12th to 15th January, 2018. Government of India vide their letter No. 4(21)/2017-coir/03 dated 09th January, 2018, has approved the deputation of Smt. Renu Kapoor, Under Secretary, IF Wing of Ministry of MSME and K.Ananda Babu, Joint Director (Planning), Coir Board for organizing the Board's participation in Domotex Fair 2018.



As per the programme, the undersigned reached Hannover on 10th January, 2018 night and Smt. Renu Kapoor reached on early After reaching Hannover, the officers morning of 11th January. proceeded to the venue of the Fair and took charge of Board's pavilion. The Board had reserved booths B 90, F 79 & F 80 in Hall No.4. All the stalls were arranged and displayed the products in an attractive way and exhibited the brochures/leaflets in a disciplined manner. The event managers who had constructed the Board's pavilion in Hall No.4 and the agency for logistics has done their duty well and the construction of pavilion and stalls were completed and the materials were reached in time. The Board displayed blow ups and posters showing the innovative products and displayed the brochures and leaflets in an attractive manner in the stall. A handbook giving the details of the participants under the Board was also printed and distributed among the visitors. This year also an Ad tower was installed in front of the venue, which attracted many visitors.

A film on coir pith, preparation of organic manure from coir pith and innovative coir products, was screened through the TV installed in the Board's stall. Further the service of a translator was also provided in Board stall. This services was utilized by the Co-exhibitors while dealing with their German counterparts. Cost Analysis

The total amount expended towards cost of exhibits, freight charges, display aids etc., worked out to Rs.30,375/-. The participation in the fair could generate a trade enquiry worth Rs. 15 crore. It is felt that there will be follow up enquiries also and if it is materialized fully, certainly this would be an addition to the national exchequer in the form of a foreign exchange. Hence the overall assessment is that the participation in Domotex Fair 2018 was very much successful and helpful for Indian Coir Industry.
