The important events/discussions/decisions pertaining to Coir Board for the period from 23.03.2018 to 26.04.2018 are furnished below.

एस&टी कार्यकलाप/ S&T ACTIVITIES

- Shri.K.Anzar, Industrial Promotion Officer, Directorate of Industries, Kavarathi, UT of Lakshdweep along with his colleague visited Central Coir Research Institute and had discussion with Director,RDTE with regard to explore the potential of coir pith composting by utilizing the accumulated coir pith in the island.
- Manufacturing of diversified coir products using Coir Cotton Fabric, Leno woven fabric etc., including handicrafts was continued during the reporting period. Different types of coir bags, chapels, suit case and table mat were produced using coir-cotton fabrics. These items were displayed in SME Convention at New Delhi. 13Kg of thin coir yarn, 30 mtr of coir cotton fabric, 10 mtrs. of leno woven fabric in different patterns and shades have been produced.





• आई आर सी अक्रिडिटेशन का नवीकरण/Renewal of IRC Accreditation

A power point presentation has been made before the accreditation committee of IRC, New Delhi in connection with the renewal of coir geotextiles by IRC. The committee has recommended for renewing the accreditation for coir geotextiles. Discussions were also held with the IRC authorities regarding the preparation of design guidelines for coir geotextiles for use in roads.

• Training on coir polyester moulding

5 days' training programme on coir polyester mouldings was conducted to the trainees at National Coir Training & Design Centre.
