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SEPARATE AUDIT REPORT OF THE COMPTROLLER AND AUDITOR GENERAL OF INDIA ON THE ACCOUNTS OF COIR BOARD FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2017

We have audited the attached Balance Sheet of Coir Board, Cochin (The Board) as at 31 March 2017 and the Income & Expenditure Account and Receipts & Payment Account for the year ended 31 March 2017 on that date under Section 19(2) of the Comptroller & Auditor General's (Duties, Powers and Conditions of Service) Act, 1971 read with Section 17(2) of the Coir Industry Act 1953. The audit has been entrusted for the period upto 31 March 2017. These financial statements include the accounts of 6 Regional Offices, 6 Sub Regional Offices, 5 Sub Offices/Extension Centres, 30 Show Rooms/Sales Depots/Sub Depots and one Commercial Unit (Hindustan Coir). These financial statements are the responsibility of the Board's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

2. This separate Audit Report contains the comments of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India (CAG) on the accounting treatment only with regard to classification, conformity with the best accounting practices, accounting standards and disclosure norms, etc. Audit observations on financial transactions with regard to compliance with the Law, Rules and regulations (Propriety and Regularity) and efficiency-com-performance aspects, etc., if any are reported through Inspection Reports/CAG's Audit Reports separately.
3. We have conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in India. These standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatements. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of financial statements. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis for our opinion.
4. Based on our audit, we report that:
 - (i) We have obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit;
 - (ii) The Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipt & Payment Account dealt with by this report have been drawn up in the format approved by the Ministry of Finance, Government of India.

(iii) In our opinion, proper books of accounts and other relevant records have been properly maintained by the Board as required under Section 19 (2) of the Comptroller & Auditor General's (Duties Powers & Conditions of Service) Act, 1971 read with section 17 (2) of the Coir Industry Act, 1953 in so far as it appears from our examination of such books.

(iv) We further report that:

A. Balance Sheet

1. Current Liabilities And Provisions - (Schedule 7)

Other Current Liabilities ₹ 1042.33 lakh

Pay commission Arrears of ₹ 245.77 lakh payable to the employees on account of implementation of 7th Central Pay Commission was accounted twice as current liability resulting in over statement of other current liabilities as well as expenditure to the tune of ₹ 245.77 lakh. Consequently, excess of income over expenditure was understated by ₹ 245.77 lakh.

2. Current Assets, Loans, Advances Etc - (Schedule 11)

Loans, Advances and Other Assets

Loans - Others - ₹ 9768.64 lakh

- a. Above includes ₹ 165.49 lakh being the advance payments made to Central Public Works Department for the works relating to Annual Maintenance Contracts of Central Coir Research Institute and Central Institute of Coir Technology units from 2011-12 onwards. Instead of charging these payments as expenditure, these were shown as advance payments which has resulted in overstatement of advances, understatement of Other Administrative Expenditure by ₹165.49 lakh. Consequently, excess of income over expenditure is overstated by the same amount.
- b. Above includes an advance of ₹ 195.36 lakh given to Directorate of Advertising and Visual Publicity (DAVP) during the period from November 2010 to December 2014 for advertisement in print and electronic media. However, as per status shown by DAVP, the balance pending as advance as of March 2017 in respect of the Board was ₹ 43.64 lakh only. The same needs reconciliation.
- c. Above includes ₹ 17.86 crore of advance payment made from 15 December 2005 to 22 February 2011 for implementation of Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI) which was yet to be reconciled despite passage of 6 years to 11 years.

Industries (SFUR71) which was yet to be reconciled despite passage of 6 years to 11 years.

- d. Above also includes other advance payments of ₹ 12.21 crore pending reconciliation for more than 10 years.

3. Current Assets, Loans, Advances Etc. - (Schedule 11)

Current Assets - Sundry Debtors

Debts Outstanding for a period exceeding six months - ₹ 123.94 lakh

Above includes debtors amounting to ₹ 64.52 lakh out of which ₹ 14.94 lakh towards show room and deport sales and others which is pending for recovery from 1978-79 to 2012-13 and against which confirmation from the concerned parties is not available. Considering the period of pendency of the amount the Board should have provided for this Sundry Debtors. Non provision of the same has resulted in overstatement of Sundry Debtors and understatement of Provision for Bad and Doubtful Debts by ₹ 14.94 lakh. Consequently, excess of income over expenditure is overstated by ₹ 14.94 lakh.

B. Grants-in-Aid

The unspent balance of Grants-in-Aid as at the beginning of the year was ₹ 16.61 crore. The Board received a sum of ₹ 91.85 crore during the year and out of it, the Board has utilised ₹ 81.15 crore leaving a balance of ₹ 27.31 crore as unutilized grants as on 31.03.2017. The same was not disclosed in the notes to Accounts.

(v) Subject to our observations in the preceding paragraphs, we report that the Balance sheet and Income & Expenditure Account/Receipts & Payments Account dealt with by this report are in agreement with the books of accounts.

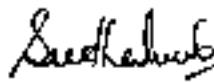

(a) in so far as it relates to the Balance Sheet, of the state of affairs of the Coir Board as at 31 March 2017; and

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(b) In so far as it relates to Income & Expenditure Account of the surplus for the year ended on that date.

- The Senior Accounts Officer (Internal Audit) holds the charge of Accounts Department also. The dual role assigned to Senior Accounts Officer may have an adverse bearing on the independence of internal audit.

• Adequacy of Internal Control System

Internal Control Mechanism requires strengthening on account of the following:

- Advances amounting to ₹ 97.68 crore were pending reconciliation as on 31 March 2017.
- Confirmation from the parties was not obtained in respect of the Sundry Debtors as on 31 March 2017.
- The Board does not have an approved Accounts Manual.
- Fixed Asset Register was not being maintained properly.

• System of Physical Verification of Assets

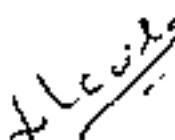
Physical Verification of Fixed Assets was not carried out during the year 2016-17.

SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1. ACCOUNTING CONVENTION

- 1.1 The financial statements are prepared on the basis of historical cost convention, unless otherwise stated and on the accrual method of accounting except subscription, interest on subscription, interest on Government Securities in Provident fund Account and interest on Savings Bank Account and interest paid to Govt. Loans which are accounted on cash basis.
- 1.2 Coir Udayam Yojana, SFUR II, MDA (DMD), Fund Received from National Research Development Centre (NRDC), Fund received from Govt. of Andaman and Nicobar Island (A & N), fund received from Singai Coir Cluster and Fund A Scheme for Promoting Innovation, Rural Industry & Entrepreneurship (ASPIRE) are treated as Earmarked / Endowment Fund.
- 1.3 The Board is having Eight schemes or funds and separate financial statements are prepared for all the schemes / funds viz. Coir Vikas Yojana, Non Plan Fund, Market Development Assistance Fund (DMD), SFUR II, Hindustan Coir, General Provident Fund, Pension Fund, and Coir Udayam Yojana and a consolidated financial statements incorporating all these schemes / funds except General Provident Fund are also prepared.
- 1.4 Interest received on Fixed Deposits, Savings Account and sales proceeds are treated as income of Earmarked / Endowment Fund.
- 1.5 The figures in the accounts are presented after rounding off to thousands.

2. INVENTORY VALUATION

Stock of furnace oil and chemicals, stationery, Stores and Spares (including machinery spares) are valued at cost and is included under stores and spares.

2.2 Raw materials and semi finished goods at factory are valued at lower of cost and net realizable value and finished goods with showrooms is valued after deducting the 20% commission and 5% Profit Margin. The finished goods at factory are valued at ex factory price.

3. FIXED ASSETS

Fixed Assets are stated at cost of acquisition inclusive of inward freight, duties and taxes and incidental and direct expenses related to acquisition

4. DEPRECIATION

Depreciation is provided on Written Down Value method on the rates consistently applied year after year. Half of the nominal rates are applied on Fixed Assets, which are used for less than 182 days. The rate of depreciation provided is as follows:-

SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1. ACCOUNTING CONVENTION

1.1 The financial statements are prepared on the basis of historical cost convention, unless otherwise stated and on the accrual method of accounting except in the case of interest on Savings Bank Account which is treated as income on cash basis.

1.2 The figures in the accounts are presented after rounding off to thousands.

2. INVENTORY VALUATION

2.1 Stores and Spares (including machinery spares) are valued at cost.

2.2 Raw materials and semi finished goods at factory are valued at lower of cost and net realizable value and finished goods with showrooms is valued after deducting the 15% commission and -0% Profit Margin. The finished goods at factory are valued at ex factory price.

3. FIXED ASSETS

Fixed Assets are stated at cost of acquisition inclusive of inward freight, duties and taxes and incidental and direct expenses related to acquisition.

Value of factory building and office building are not separately shown in the books of accounts since the rate of depreciation is same for both.

4. DEPRECIATION

Depreciation is provided on Written Down Value method on the rates consistently applied year after year. Half of the normal rates are applied on Fixed Assets, which are used for less than 182 days.

5. ACCOUNTING FOR SALES

Sales are net of sales returns, rebate and trade discount.

6. GOVERNMENT GRANTS/SUBSIDIES

6.1 Market Development Assistance received from Coir Board is treated as revenue.

7. RETIREMENT BENEFITS

7.1 Provision for accumulated leave encashment benefit to the employees is not provided in the accounts.
