• The 10th Meeting of Coir & Coir Products Sectional Committee, BIS (Bureau of Indian Standards)TXD 25 was held on 11th September, 2018 at CCRI, Kalavoor with participation of representatives from BIS, FICEA, Trade from Karnataka, Kerala & Tamil Nadu and scientists from CCRI/CICT.



• A team of 15 students and faculty from the Department of International Environment and Development Studies, Norwegian University of Life Sciences working on environmental and ecological research visited Coir Board Complex, at Kalavoor and had an interaction session on coir in the chamber of the Director, RDTE on 13/09/2018.



## 27th Scheme Steering Committee (SSC) Meeting

The 27<sup>th</sup> Scheme Steering Committee (SSC) meeting was held at Ministry of MSME, New Delhi on 12.09.2018 under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Secretary, MSME, Govt. of India. The committee has approved 6 more SFURTI clusters in coir sector. They are Tarapur(Gujarat), Ambalapuzha (Kerala), Andaman (UT of Andaman & Nicobar), Bhograi, Konark and Rajkanika (Odisha) coir clusters with a total GoI grant of Rs.1142.63 lakhs. The committee has accorded approval for these cluster proposals with a view to enhance the enrolment of artisans and also to diversify the products.

#### स्वच्छता ही सेवा/Swachha Hi Sewa(SHS)

As part of Swachh Bharath Mission "Swachhta Hi Sewa" fortnight celebrations started from 15th September to 2nd October-2018. The employees of the Board took Swachhta Pledge on 15.09.2018 in Head Office and Sub Offices of the Board. In Head Office, the Pledge was administered by Shri M.Kumararaja, Secretary, Coir Board. Shri V.P.Gopalakrishnan, Administrative Officer & Nodal Officer for SBM delivered an introductory speech highlighting the importance of Swachhta Hi Sewa programme. After the Swachhta Pledge, cleanliness drives were also conducted in different Sections in the Office and its outside premises.

In order to observe the "Swachhta Hi Sewa" fortnight celebrations, Almirahs and cupboards in various Sections in Head Office and Sub Offices were cleaned and labelled with paper pasted on top right side of the almirahs indicating number of almirah, name of the custodian etc.. during the period from 17<sup>th</sup> September to 19<sup>th</sup> September , 2018. 
