• ECOMARK: The Ministry of Environment, forest & climate Change had convened the Steering Committee Meeting on 3rd August 2018 for approving the Criteria of Ecomark for coir and coir products.

• Coir Board attended the Ist meeting of the Rural Roads committee (H-5) to frame Guidelines for use of Coir & Jute geotextiles on roads held on 14th August, 2018 at IRC, R.K. Puram, New Delhi. The meeting was chaired by Shri D.P. Gupta, Former DG (Road Development), Convenor, Dr. I.K. Pateriya. Director, NRRDA and Co-Convenor & Shri A.V. Rajesh, Member-Secretary and members of the Technical Committee Section, IRC. A presentation was made by the Director RDTE highlighting the results of studies carried out on the application of coir geotextiles for reinforcement of rural roads with

all the collaborative Institutes viz the NIT's at Trichy, Kozhikode & Bhopal and College of Engineering Thiruvananthapuram. It was decided to constitute a subgroup of experts for the proposed work under the guidance of the Convener.

Export

The final figures of export of coir and coir products during the year 2017-18 is valued at Rs.2532.28 crores for a quantum of 1016564 MT. It shows an increase of 6.2 % in terms of value and 11% in terms of quantity when compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.

Facilitation in the Source Direct at ASD, 2018

Coir Board facilitated participation of the MSME Units in the Source Direct at ASD held during 29 July to 1 August, 2018 at Las Vegas, USA. The participation was very fruitful and the participants could generate a lot of trade enquiries and firm business orders for coir products.

• External Market Development Assistance

An amount of Rs.1,59,400/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Nine Thousand Four Hundred only) has been disbursed to a Unit as External Market Development Assistance for various export promotional activities abroad.

• Export Registration

Six firms were newly registered as Coir Exporters and also issued Registration-Cum-Membership Certificates.
